- Inspired Wildcat

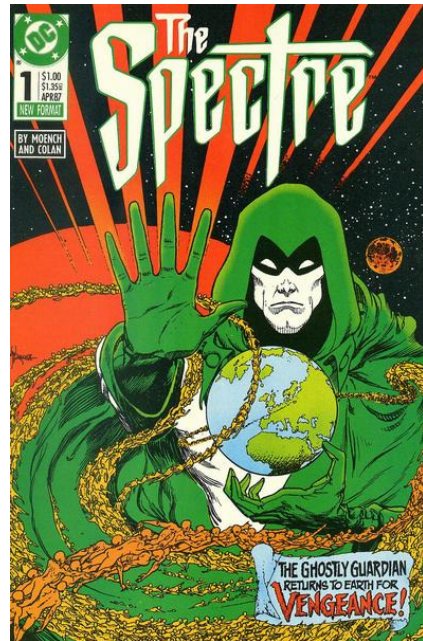

He turned Dr. Light into a candle and melted him.

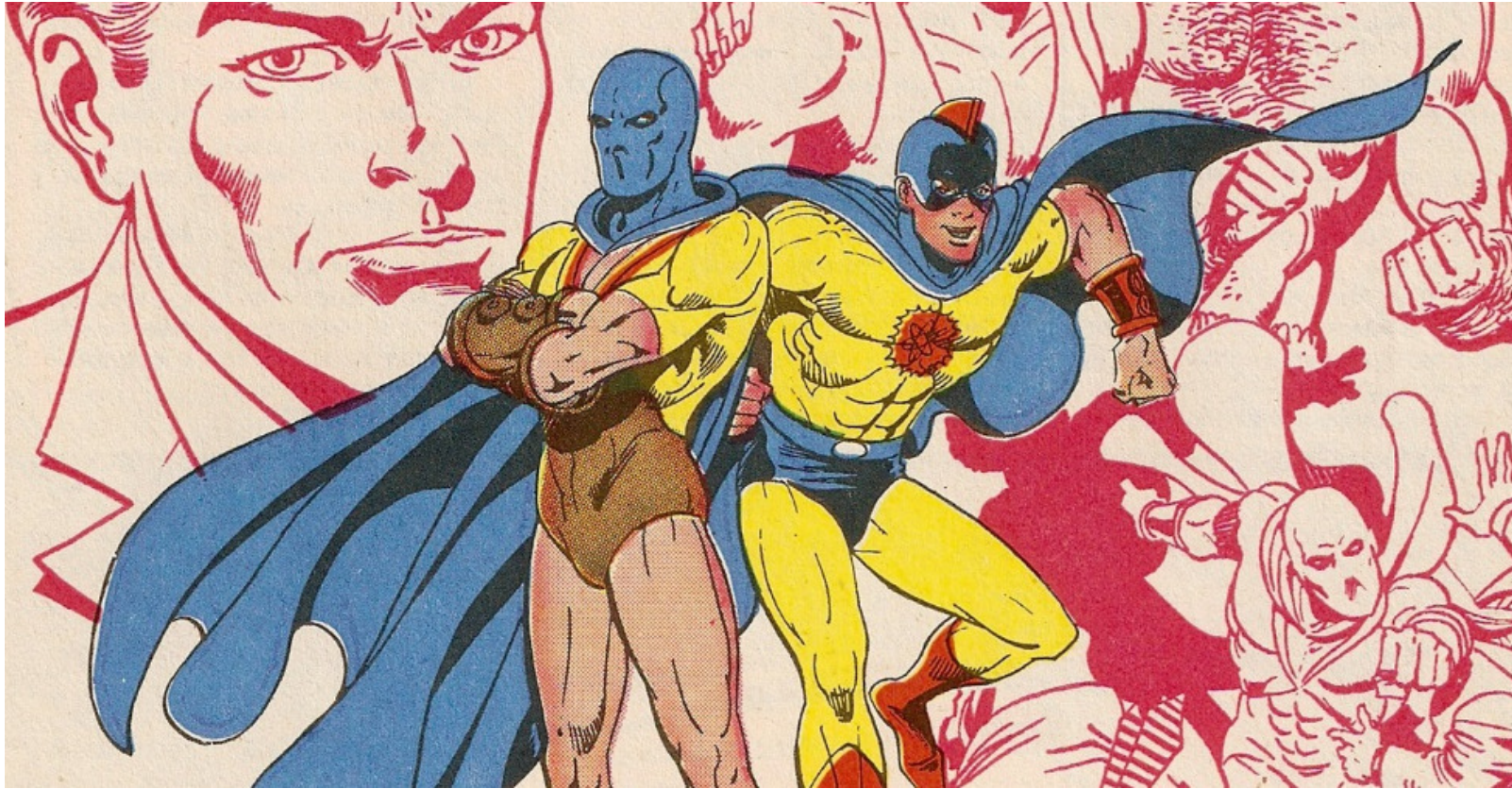

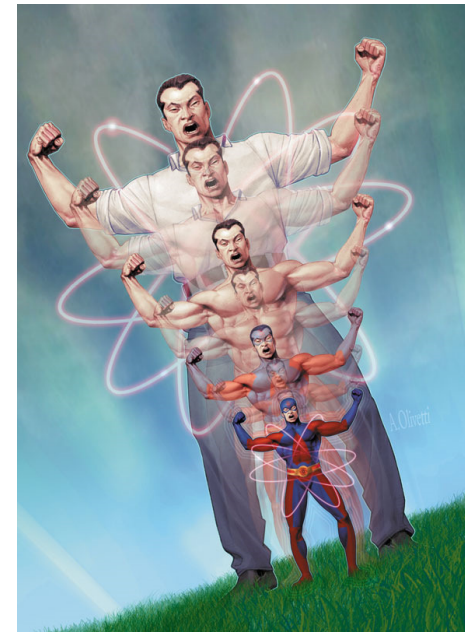

- **HOBBIES:** Boxing, fighting crime, getting killed by Extant.



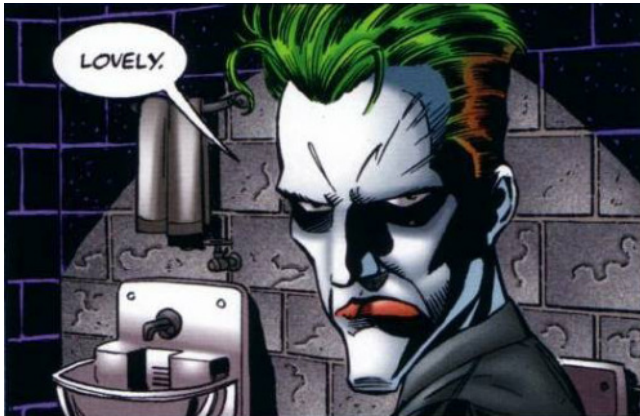
- Short guy that got sick of being picked on.

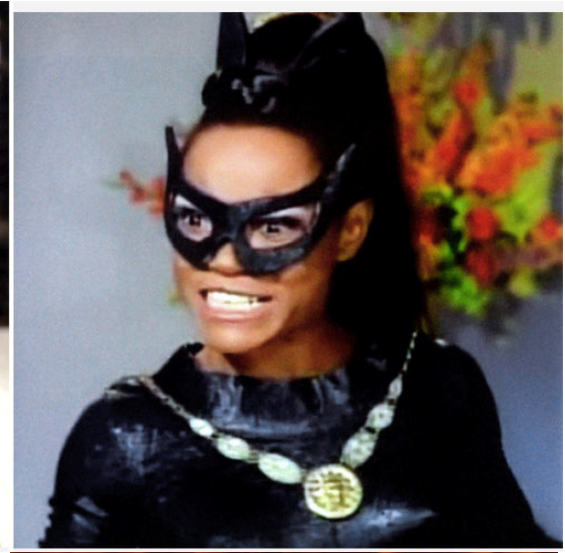
Yes, Catwoman really wore this mask at one point.
